Applications are invited from Indian nationals to work as a Junior Research Fellow under the SERB funded project: 'Study of scalar perturbations in cosmological models of Dark Energy' (Sanction No: EMR/2016/007162) under the supervision of Dr. Sudipta Das, Principal Investigator, Department of Physics, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan. Candidates should have M.Sc. in Physics with minimum 55% marks and NET and/or GATE qualification and age below 28 years at the time of application (relaxable as per the norms/orders of Government of India). Salary: Rs. 25000 + HRA (as per DST guidelines).

The tenure is valid till the completion of the project. The post is purely temporary and coterminus with the duration of the project. Candidate selected for this position can also apply for the regular PhD program of Visva-Bharati provided the candidate satisfy the eligibility criteria.
