**Minimum Eligibility Criteria for Assistant Professor:**

- Good academic record as defined by the concerned University with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Masters Degree level in a relevant subject along with relaxation applicable to specified categories as explained in the **Note -1.**
- The candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC/CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like NET/SET along with exemptions to specified categories as explained in the **Note- 2.**

**Note 1: Relaxation of Marks for Recruitment of Assistant Professor:**

- A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the Graduate Masters level for the Schedule Castes / Scheduled Tribes / Differently - abled (physically and visually Differently -abled)/ other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching position. However differently-abled (physically and visually) candidates are not eligible for any marks relaxation in Physical Education discipline.
- The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- All the essential qualification must have been obtained from a recognized University /Institute. By a University /Institute is meant a University /Institute affiliated to UGC/other statutory apex bodies, or recognized by State or Central Government as a centre for higher learning. In case of a foreign University, the Degree concerned should be recognized as equivalent to its Indian counterpart by the Association of Indian Universities.

- iv) Ph.D. in concerned subject is preferable.

**Note 2: NET/SLET/SET Exemption for the post of Assistant Professor:**

- i) The candidates who have been awarded Ph.D. degree in the same or in relevant subject in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET).
- ii) Candidates registered for Ph.D. programme prior to 11 July, 2009 shall be exempted from the qualifying in the Eligibility Test (NET/SLET/SET) as described hereinafter  
The award of Degree to candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to 11 July, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances/Bye laws/ Regulations of the institutions awarding the Degree in the same or relevant subject shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET. Subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:
- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only.  
b) Evaluation of Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners.  
c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted.  
d) Candidate has published two research papers from his /her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal.  
e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conference/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.

**(a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).**

**Steps for Application for the Post of Assistant Professor in different Subjects and online Payment of Application fees:**

1. Application for the post of Assistant Professor in different subjects at Directorate of Open & Distance Learning, University of Kalyani starts from 02<sup>nd</sup> August, 2019 and closes on 08<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.
2. Applicants are advised to visit the university website <http://www.klyuniv.ac.in> or <http://dodl.klyuniv.ac.in> for downloading application forms and payment of application fees.
3. For downloading Application Form, click 'Application Form for Recruitment of Assistant Professor (contractual) for DODL, K.U.'
4. After payment of Application Fee (Steps furnished below), duly filled in Application Form of the applicant and copy of e-receipt of SB Collect (in PDF format) has to be sent to the E-mail Id: [dodlrecruitment@klyuniv.ac.in](mailto:dodlrecruitment@klyuniv.ac.in) on or before 08<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.

### **Steps: Depositing the Payment of Application Fees:**

1. Applicants should visit the <https://www.onlinesbi.com> Link for payment.
2. Applicants should select "SB Collect" from the menu.
3. On the "SB Collect" page, the applicant should check at the end of the Disclaimer Clause to proceed for payment (  I have read and accepted the terms and conditions stated above).
4. In the next page, the applicant should select "State of Corporate Institution' (West Bengal) and 'Type of Corporate/Institution' (Educational Institutions) from the drop down menu and click GO.
5. Next the Applicants should select from Educational Institutions Name 'DODL University of Kalyani A/C SB Collect' from the drop down Menu and click Submit.
6. In the next page, the Applicant is required to fill up the payment details in prescribed proforma and click Submit.
7. In the next page, the applicant should Select Payment Category 'Application for the Post of Asst. Professor (contractual)'.
8. After confirmation of the payment details, the Applicant can make payment through Net Banking/Credit Card/Other Payment modes.
9. In the other payment mode, the applicant can download and print the Pre-Acknowledgement payment challan and make the payment through any SBI Branch. After successful submission of the payment, applicants have to download the e-receipt of SB collect.
10. Please note that the Bank Charges for each payment mode is different.
11. After successful submission of the payment of application fee a SB Collect Reference Number will be generated online.
12. In case of payment by cash through Pre-Acknowledgement payment challan, the bank will write the Transaction ID on the challan.
13. Each applicant is required to write the SB Collect Reference No. in the relevant column of the Application Form.
14. No application will be accepted without the payment of application fees after 4.00 p.m (by bank counter payment) and 11.45 p.m (online mode) on 08<sup>th</sup> August, 2019.
