QUALIFICATIONS:

Essential:

(A) Graduate of a recognized university in Science (With Physics as one of the subjects), Technology or Engineering;

– OR –

Holds a recognized diploma in Engineering with three years experience in the field of Engineering in which the candidate has earned the diploma or in the field of Legal Metrology;

and -

(B) is able to speak, read and write the regional language of the state, i.e., Bengali / Nepali for the candidates whose mother tongue is Nepali.

AGE: Not more than 32 years on 01.01.2017.

- 1. The qualifications prescribed in the advertisement are as per the notified recruitment rules issued by Government.
