Essential Qualifications:

B.Sc or M.Sc. degree with minimum average marks of 60% in chemistry from a recognized university or institute and should have qualified UGC/CSIR.

Preference will be given to the candidates with Ph.D. degree in chemistry or those who submitted the thesis and awaiting the award of Ph.D degree. The later candidates must produce a letter from his/her Ph.D. supervisor stating that the thesis has been submitted and the final viva/defence is pending.

Fellowship: Approx. Rs. 54000/- per month (Fixed).

Duration: The position is for **three years** or completion of the project, whichever is earlier.

This post is purely temporary. The initial appointment will be done for six months, which is subject to an extension of up to three years based on the candidate performance review (after each six month duration).

No TA will be admissible for attending the interview.

The applications will be shortlisted based on academic credentials. Shortlisted candidates will be requested to appear for an interview in second week of May, 2025. The exact date of the interview will be communicated to the shortlisted candidates only.
