

**DETAILS FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF DATA ENTRY OPERATOR IN THE

1. Name of the Post. : Data Entry Operator.
2. No. of the vacancy. : 05 (Five)
3. Educational Qualification. : Applicant has to possess a **degree in graduation with at least 'O' level certificate in Computer Application.**
4. Terms & Condition. : Engagement shall be purely on contractual basis / temporary basis for a period of 01 (one) year. This can be renewed at satisfactory performance by the Finance Department on recommendation of the District Magistrate.
5. Consolidated Pay. : a) Consolidated remuneration of Rs. 11,000/- P.M.
b) Annual increment benefit will be @ Rs. 5,00/- to each operator for the first 05 (five) years and then @ Rs. 600/- thereafter. This is subject to continuous satisfactory service.
6. One copy of self attested colour photograph to be pasted on the application Form.
7. Incomplete application Form or without supporting documents shall be outright rejected.
8. Mode of Examination. : The engagement will be done through written test followed by Computer test and interview. i.e, Written test will be of 40 Marks comprising English (10 Marks), Mathematics (10 Marks), General Knowledge (10 Marks) & Computer (10 Marks).

Computer Practical Test and Interview will be of 30 Marks each.
